The band was specially chosen for the occasion as they promise guests will party harder and sing louder, listening to classic rock ‘n’ roll “the way it was meant to be played.”

In addition, Brewerkz 10th Anniversary Limited Edition pint glasses will be available for sale, and guests can drink their beer from the glass and take it home by topping up with an extra \$5.

Guests can also expect to polish off their meals with delicious birthday cake served to everyone at the restaurant on the night.

Managing director and co-founder, Devin Otto Kimble says, “Taking the celebrations one step further we will bring back our most popular promotion ever - ‘Monday Madness’. On June 11, guests can purchase beer for \$1 between 5 and 6pm. (Limited to three cups per person).”

From June 11-15, in the lead-up to the 10th anniversary, Brewerkz will step back in time and resurrect their infamous weekday lunch deal offering guests three pints and a starter, free with every main course purchase from 12noon to 4pm.
